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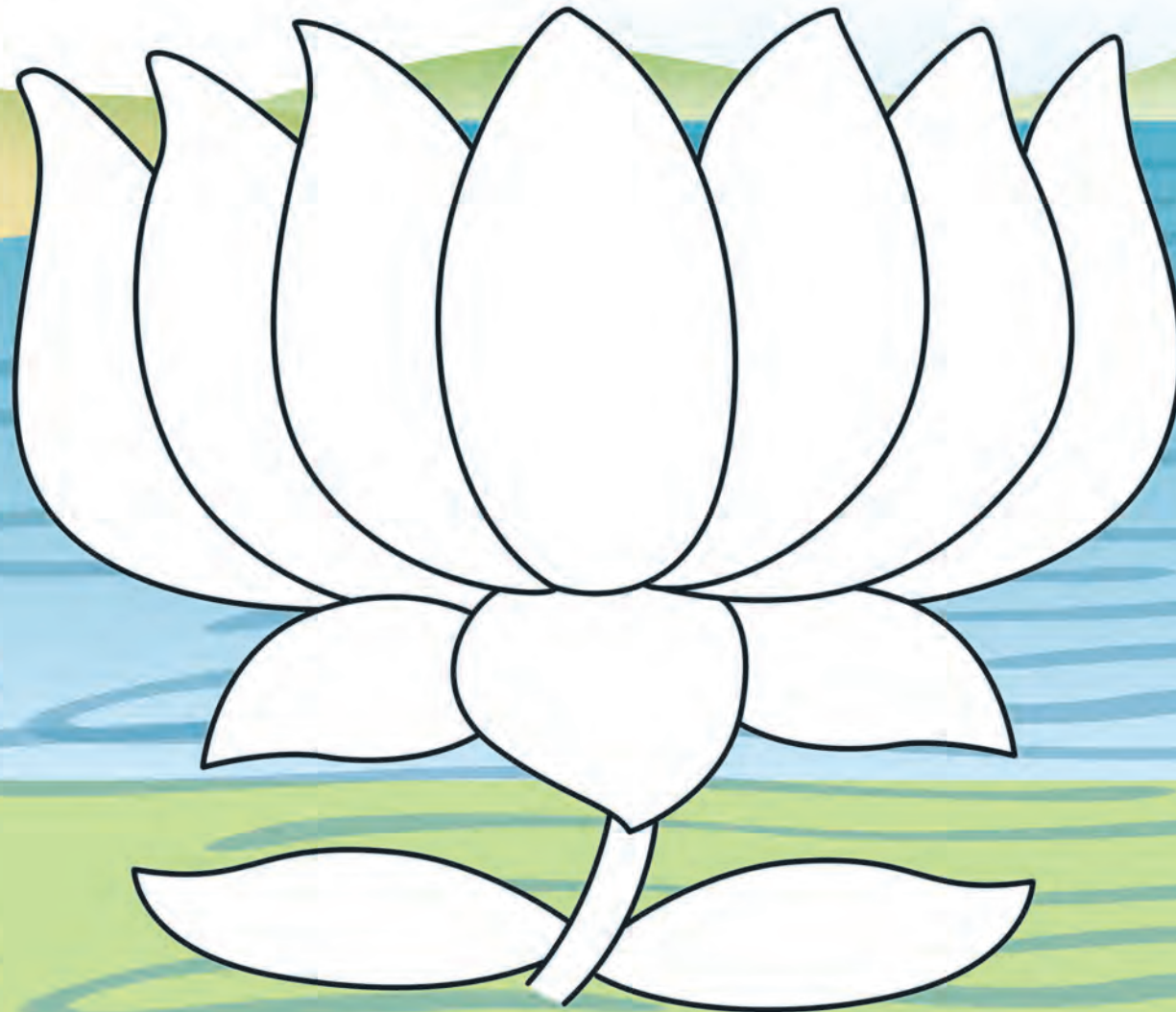


# Lotus - (Earbud impressions)

Collect some grass from nearby park and tie it as shown.



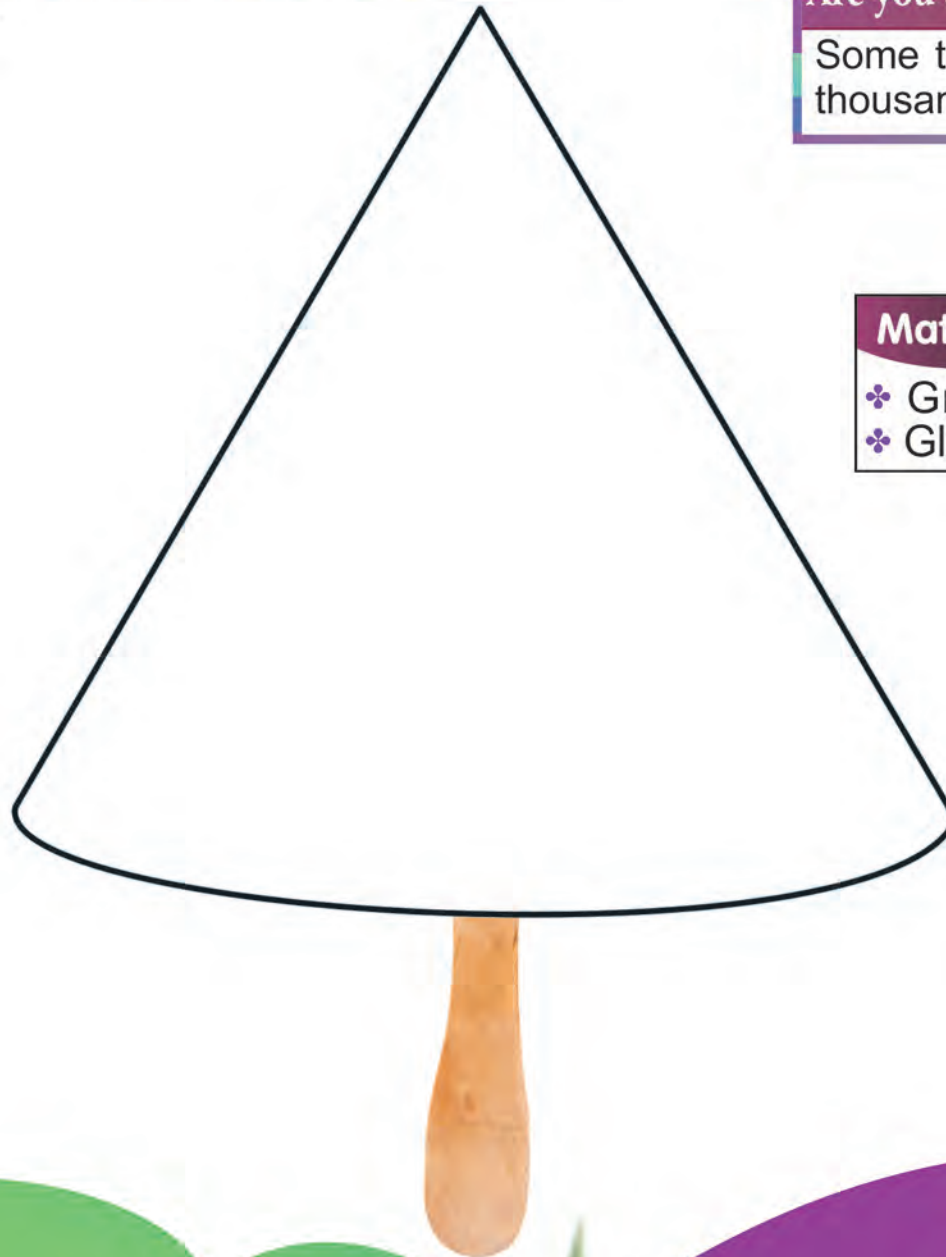
Step-2

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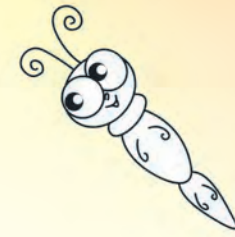
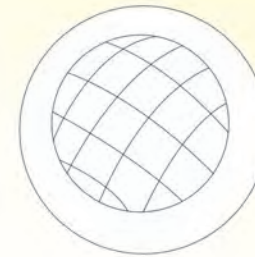


# Sunflower - (Leaf impressions)

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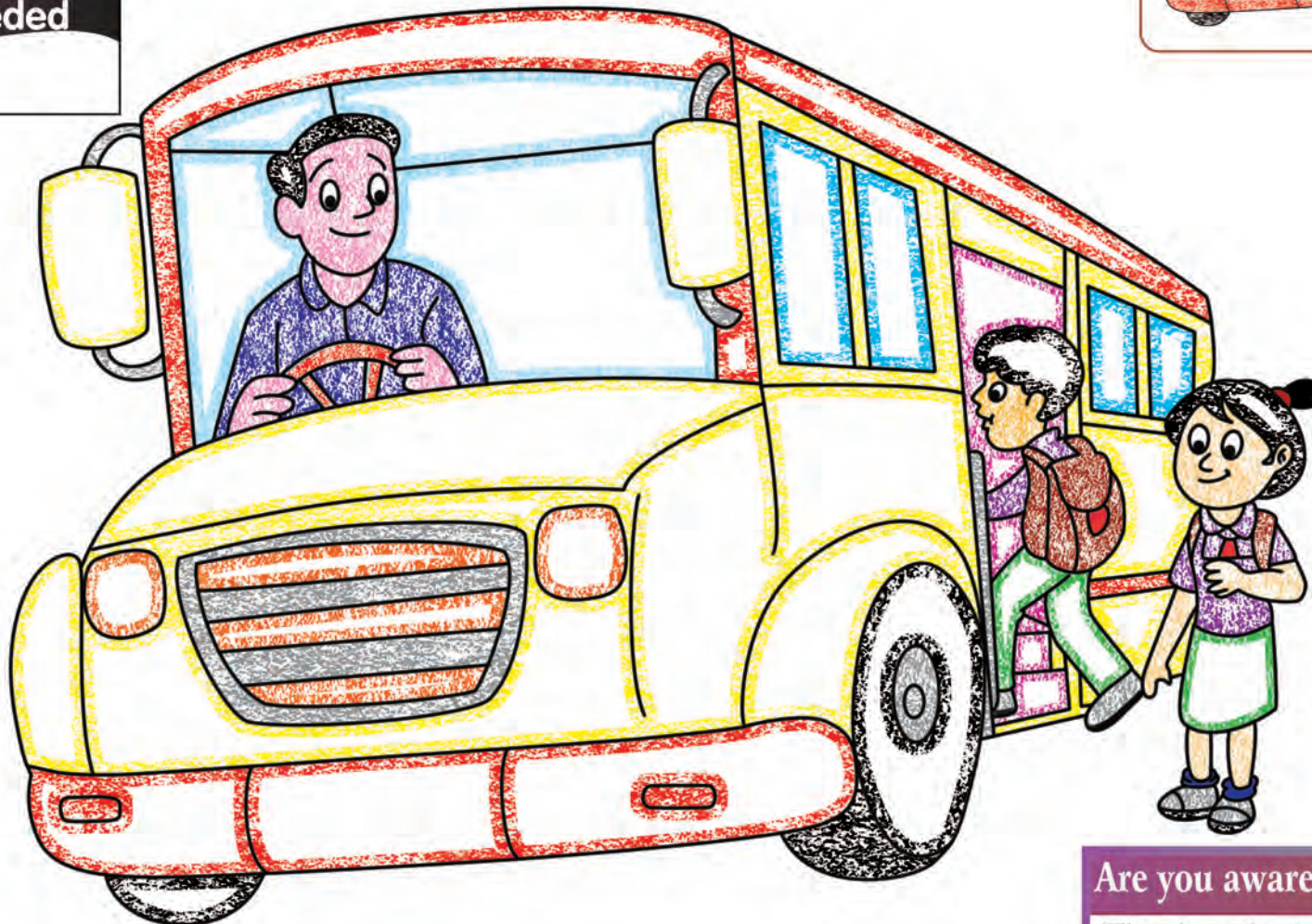

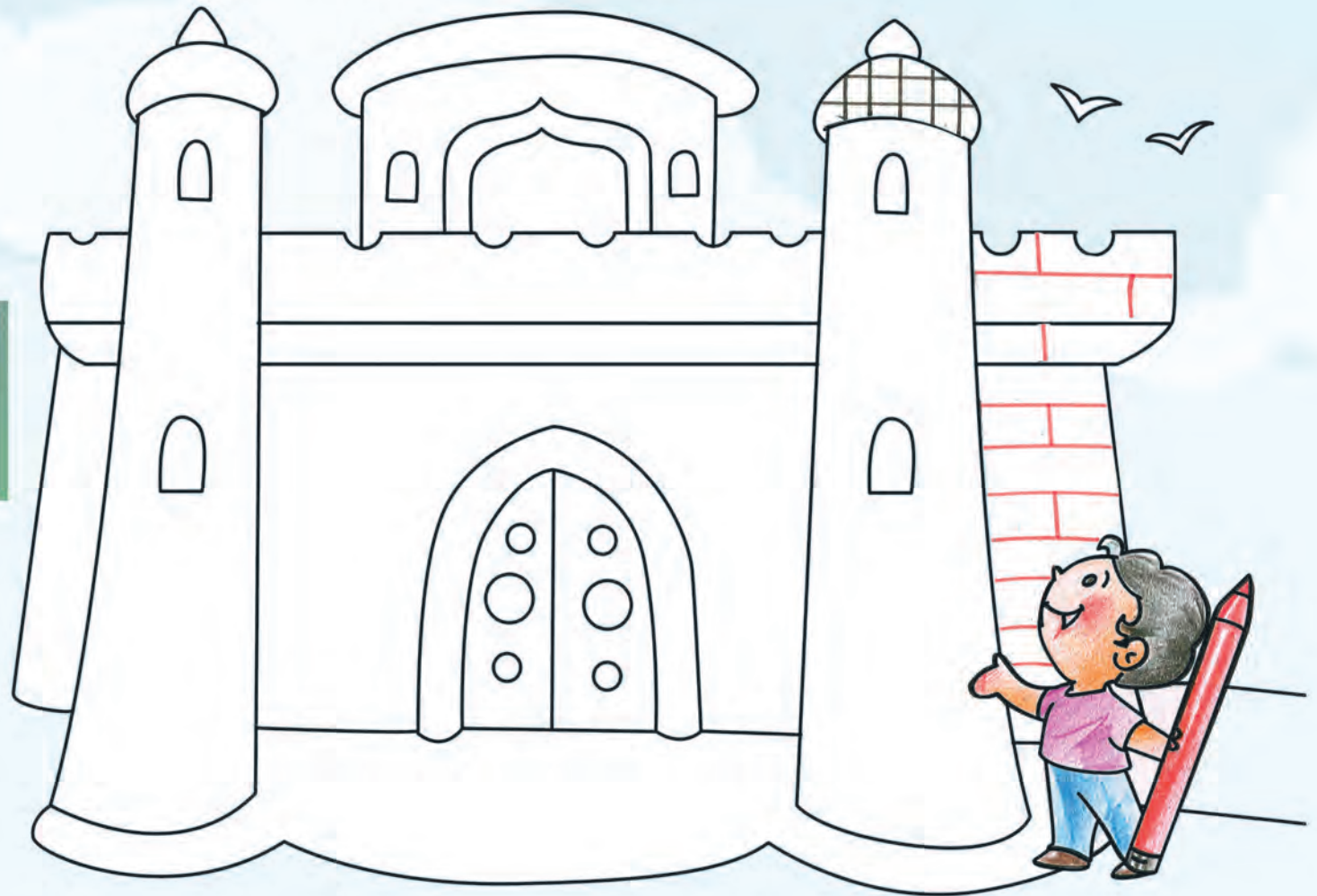

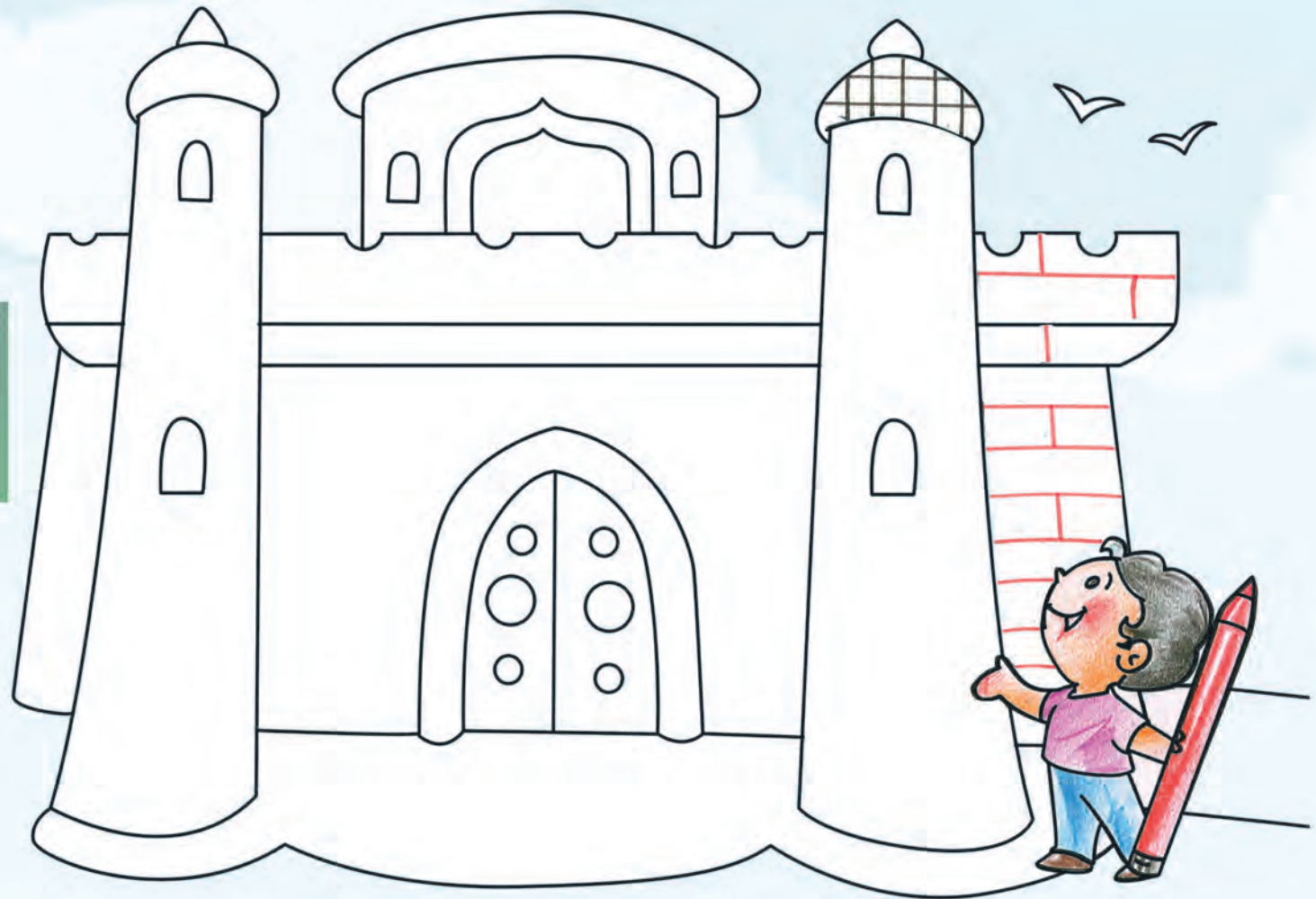

✦ Rubber bands



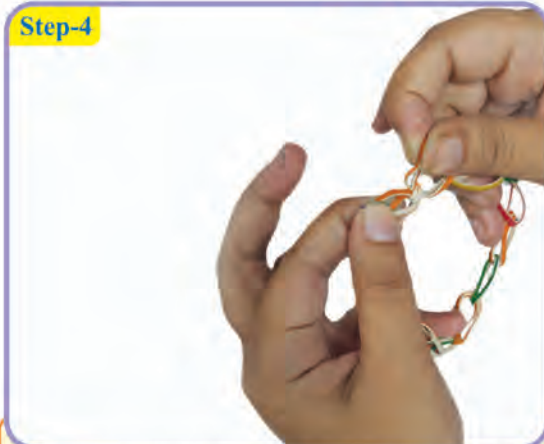
Take some multi-coloured rubber bands.

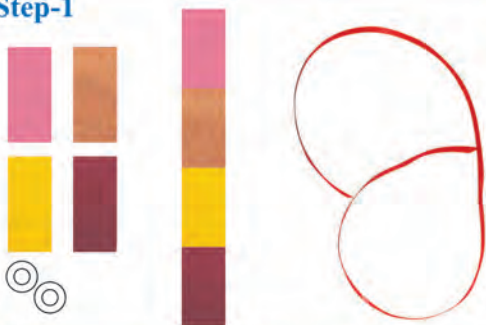

Step-3



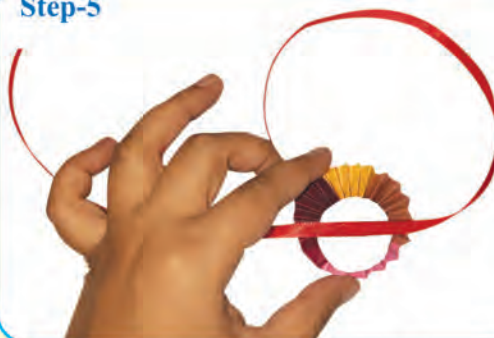
Paste both the edges of the strips.

Step-4



Spread the folded strip in the shape of a wheel and paste a bead or star in the middle as shown.

Step-5



Now paste one circle cutout at the back side, then paste ribbon or coloured thread and finally paste second circle cutout over them.

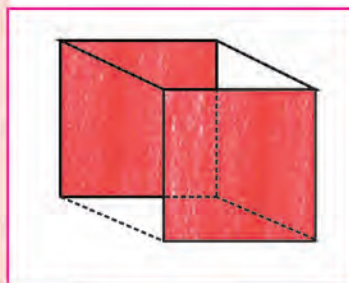
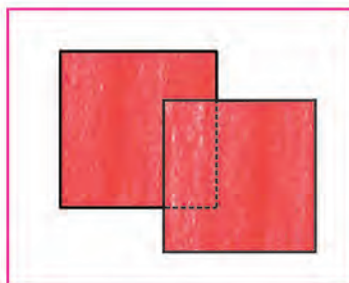

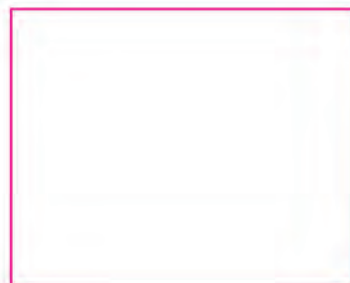
# 3-D Shapes - (Drawing)

### Step-4



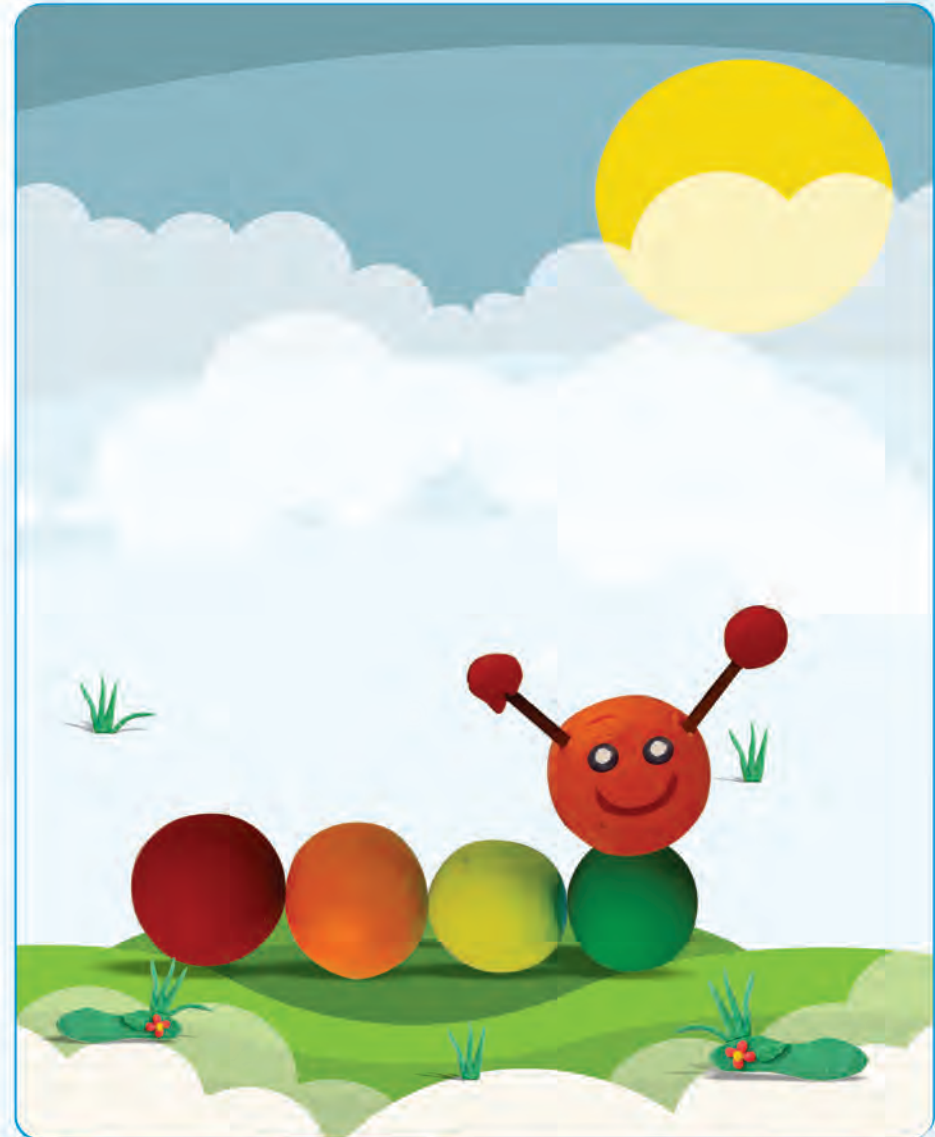
Make two tiny balls of clay. Attach the balls with sticks as shown. Paste googly eyes to complete the caterpillar.

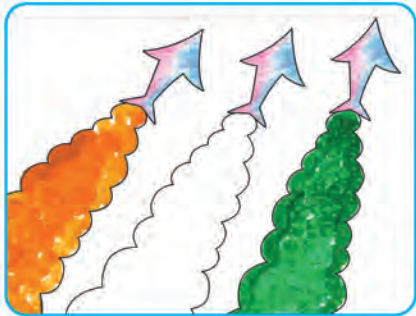

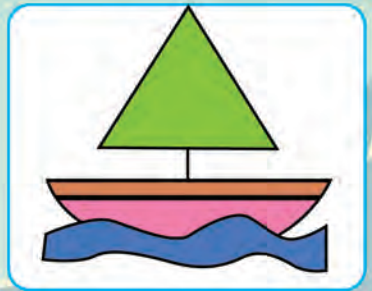
# Boat (Learn to Draw)

Row-row-row your boat!

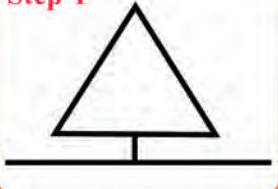
Learn to draw a boat with the help of basic shapes. Use pencil colours and make the boat row along.

### Step-2

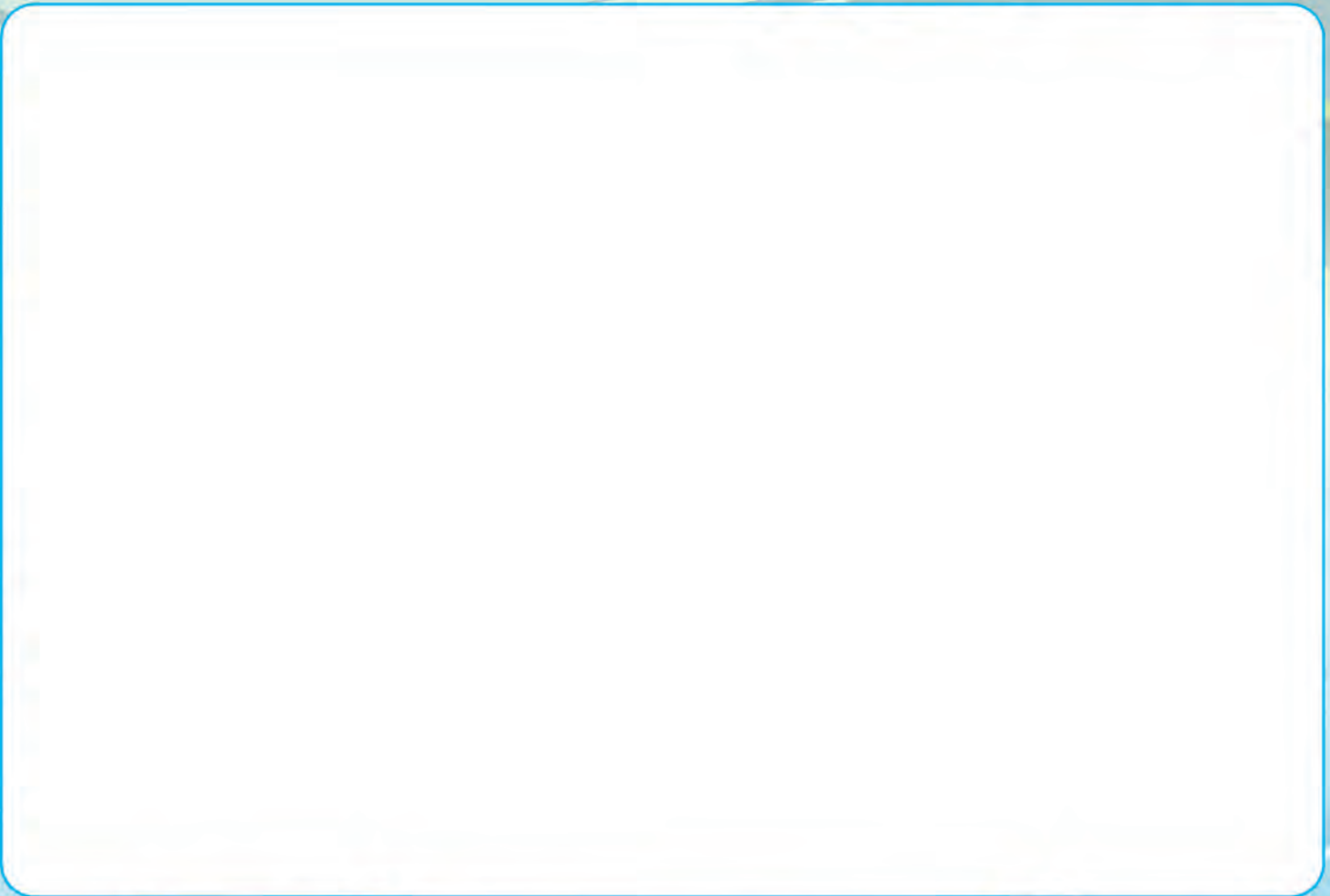


Make a semi-circle from the line drawn.
