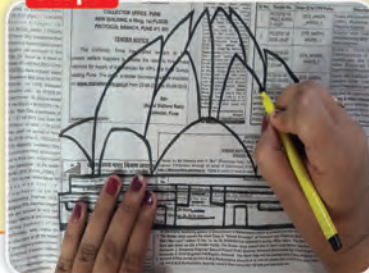
Lotus Temple - (Newspaper Art)

Take a black sketch pen and draw the outline of the Lotus Temple on the news paper sheet.

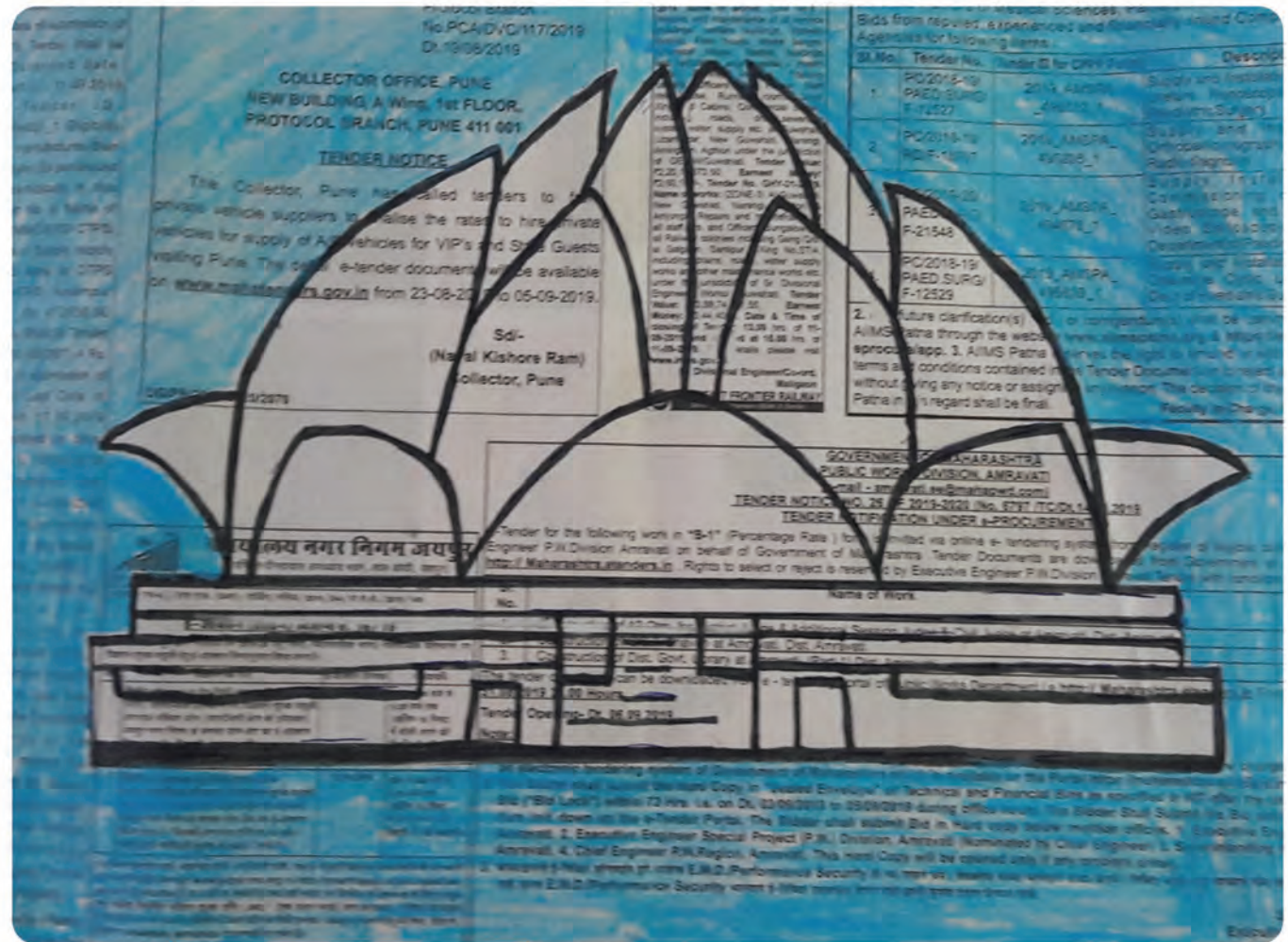

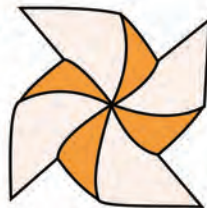

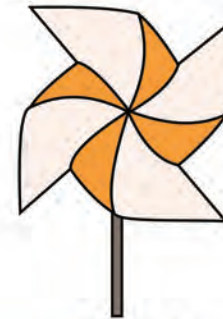

Step 1: Colour the blank space given with crayons using a variety of colours.



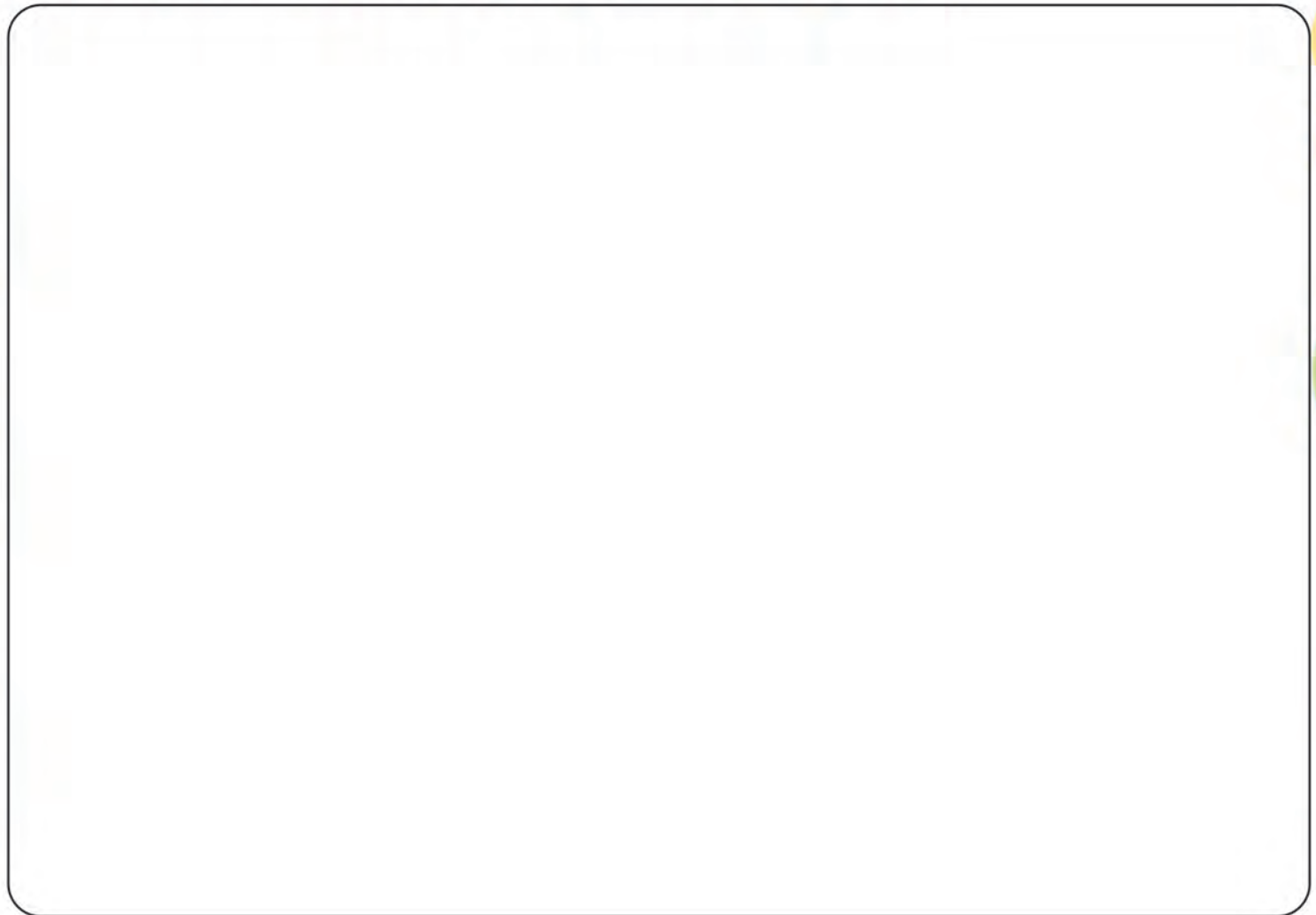
Step 2: Now colour the entire space with black poster colour. Let it dry.
