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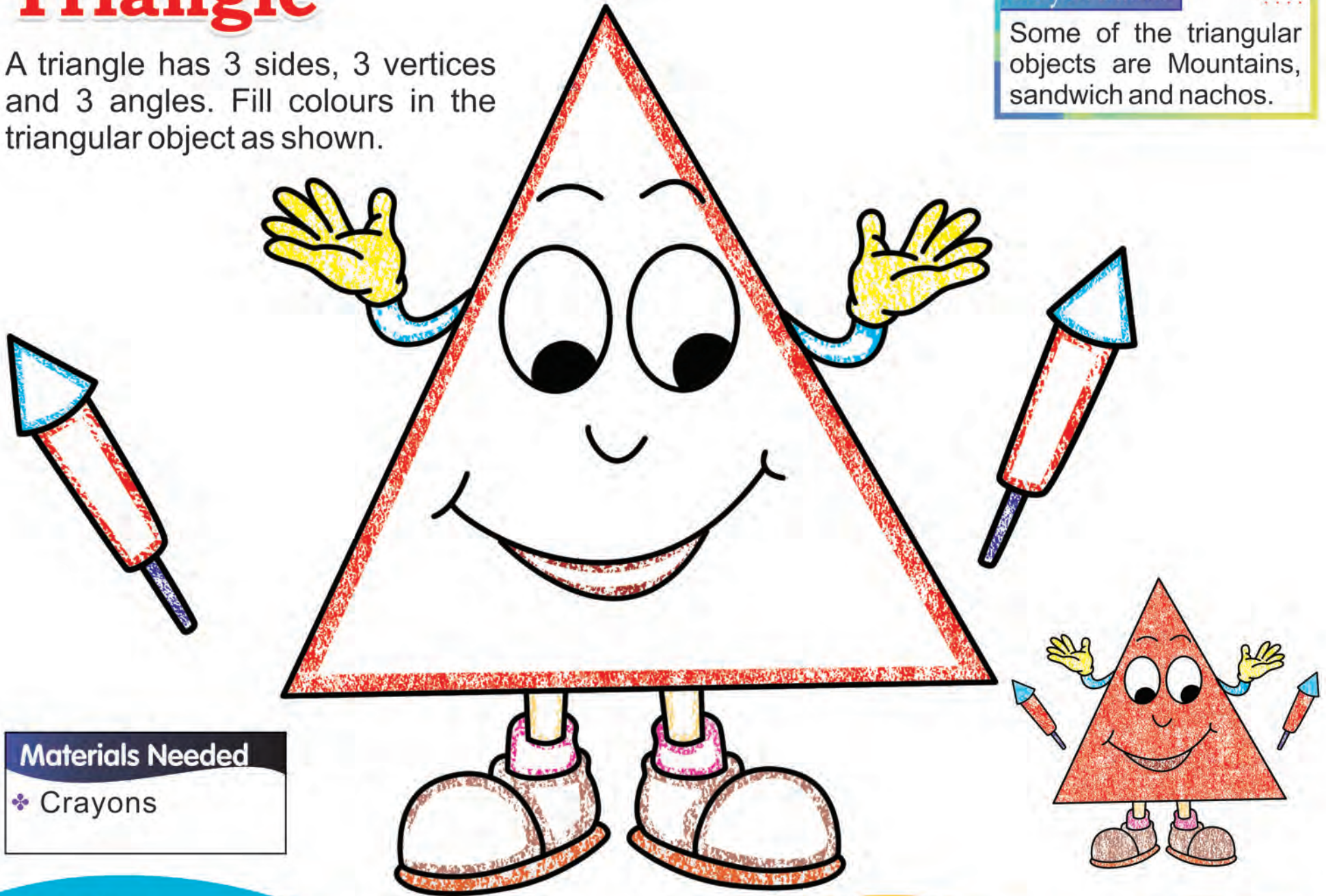
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Triangle

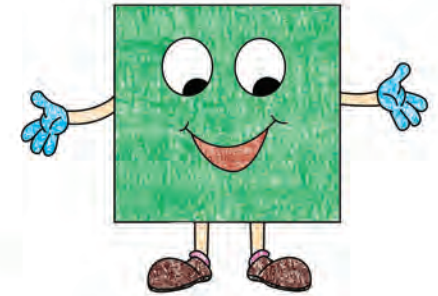
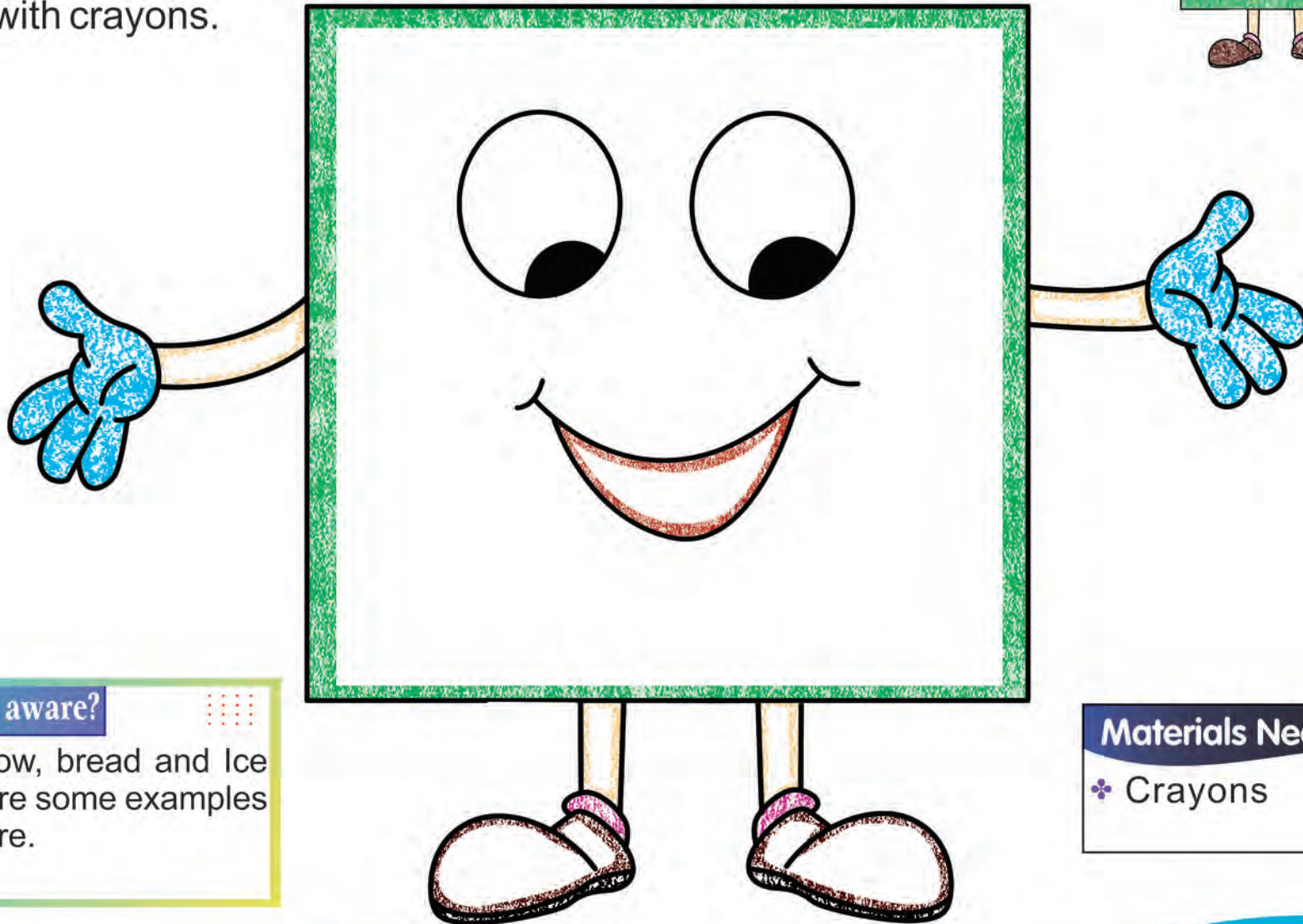

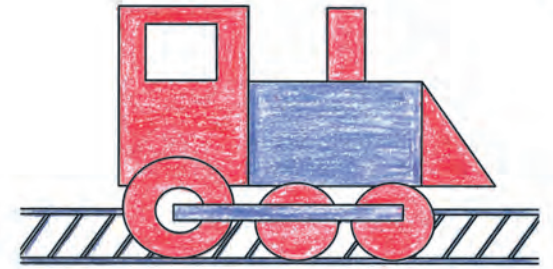

This engine is made up of different shapes. Identify the shapes and colour the engine as shown.



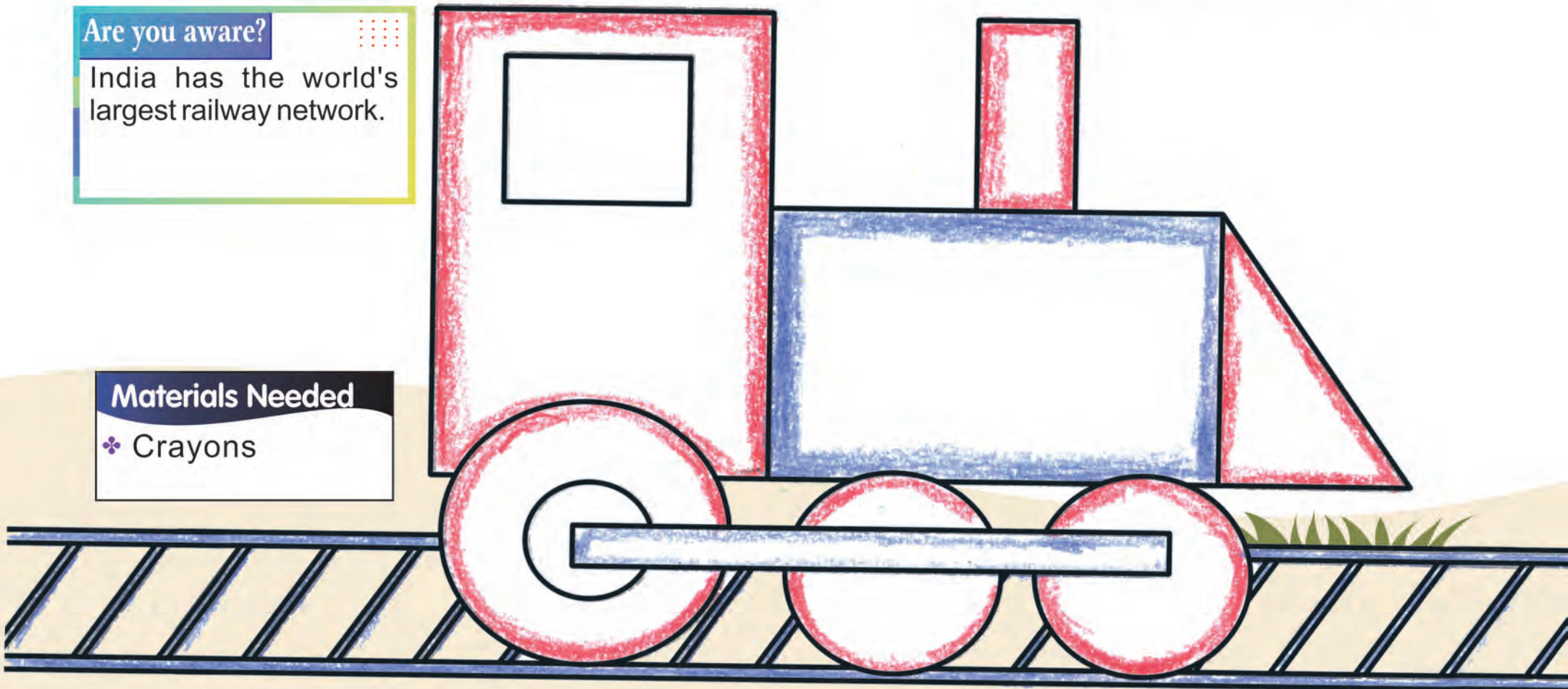

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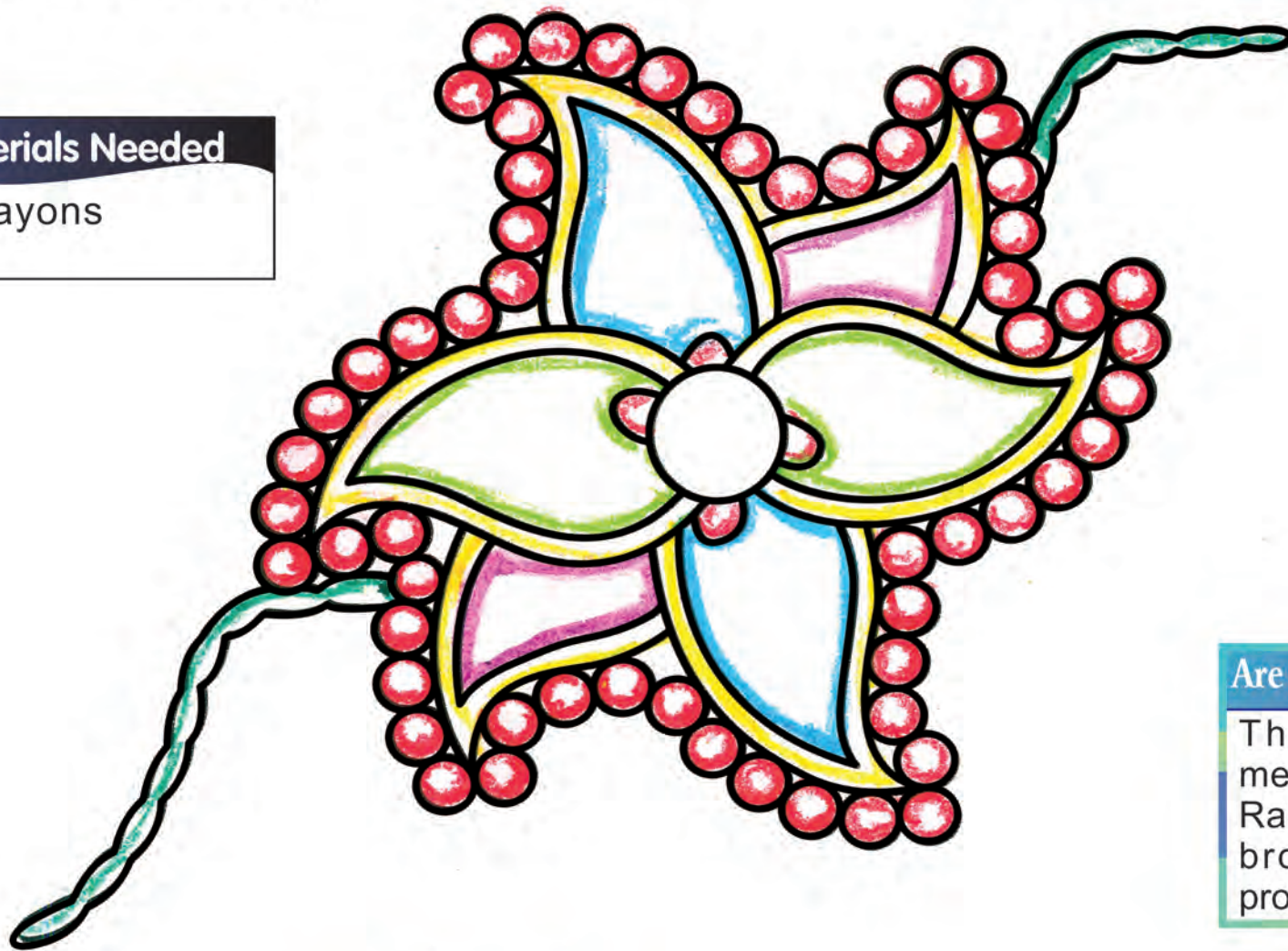
Raksha Bandhan
