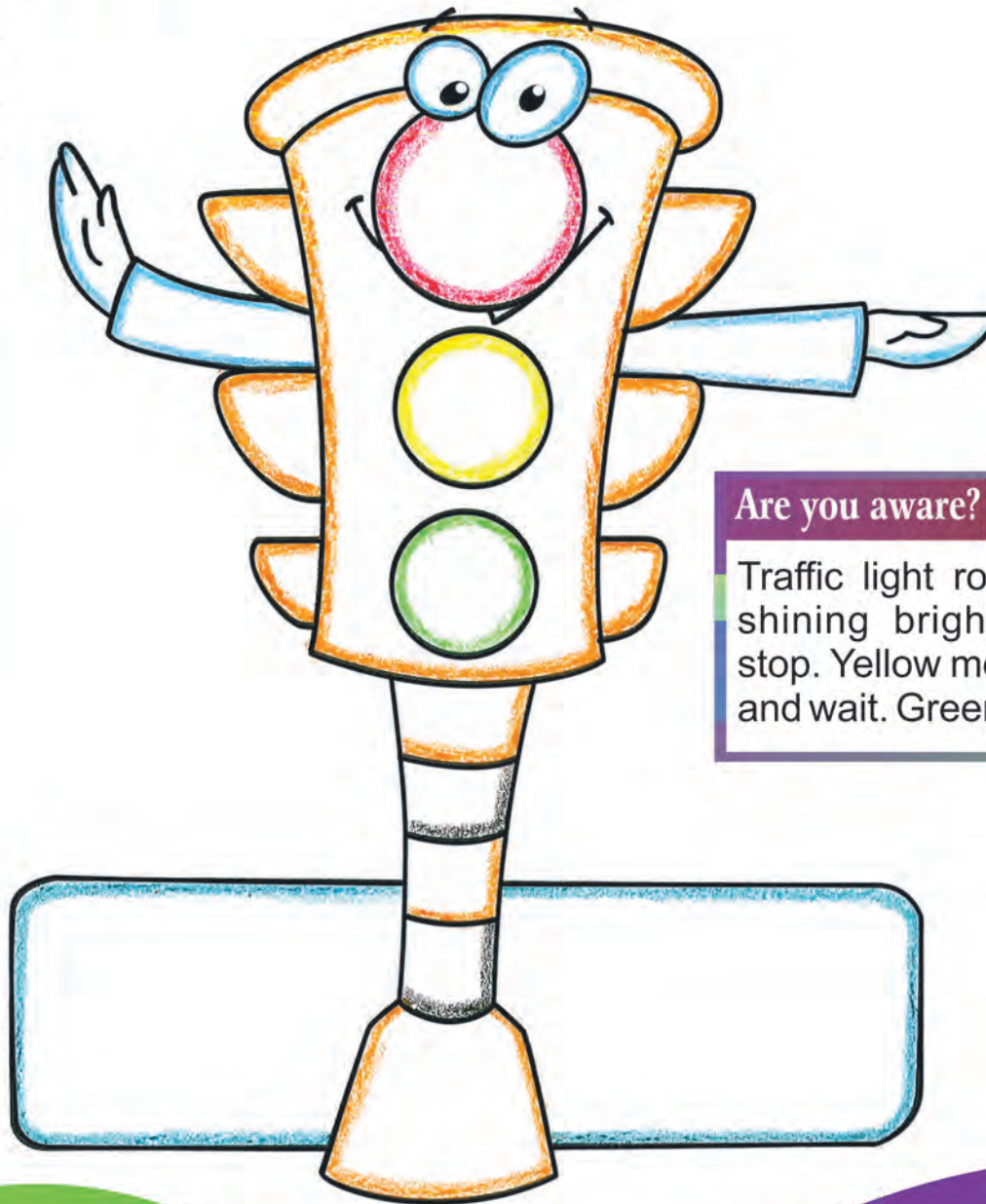
Traffic Lights

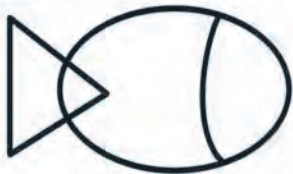

Elephant – (Play with Clay)

Step-1



Roll the blue dough into an egg's shape for the body. For the trunk, roll the ball into a sausage-like shape, one end of which is thinner than the other.

Step-2



Then, fix the trunk to the body of the elephant.

Step-3



Pierce the dough with the help of the pencil/pen, to make the eyes of the elephant.

Step-4



Take the blue dough to form the elephant's ears and fix them on its head.

Step-5



To form the elephant's tail and legs take some more blue dough by rolling it into small sausage-like shapes.

Step-6



Fix the legs and tail on the elephant's body.

Step-7



To make the elephant's eyes, tusks and nails take the white clay and fix these on its body. Put two tiny round pieces of orange clay for its eyeballs.

Step-8



Now jumbo elephant is ready to play football with you.
